This main activity of the project is perfectly suited to create a context where citizens can interact and discuss European subjects based on the expertise of each partners. Some partners focus on the addressing and breaking stereotypes on migrants and refugees while other have chosen to focus on Interculturalism in art and culture which brings us together. Yet other partners have chosen to focus on shifting the rhetoric, especially the sensationalist narratives that allow for the irrationality of xenophobia and replace it with an honest discussion on tectonic societal shifts like automation and demographic changes. However, the more focused part should be to discuss the EU as a force to be interacted with and understood in the context of the challenges faced and the need for EU policies to be as representative of the vast majorities of the populations as possible.

Structural dialogues: the participants will exchange impressions with EU expert about the EU Mission, Vision and values and policies. They will cover the important challenge of the EU in order to keep its values, mission and vision using as examples the challenge in the framework of migration.

Workshops: Workshops will be focus on the Know-how of the citizens participatory process where participant will understand the EU policy making process, moreover it will be discuss the views on the refugee crisis, how it is being handled, what actions have been made and what should be made (according to their point of view) on an EU level. At the same time, reference on the EU values and EU policies in this framework. The Participants will exchange impressions with EU Politician and experts. The aim is that the young/NGDOS participants give their point of view on the challenge of the EU and specific on the refugee crisis and make suggestions on its best management.
