The consortium of the project CivAct is planning to hold its Migration and EU conferences in Athens Greece, Grenoble France, Nicosia Cyprus, Lisbon Portugal, Merida Spain, Foligno Italy and Catania Italy over the next few months. Within the framework of building capacities partners will try to employ volunteers from the EU Solidarity Corps to help with the organization of the event in each country.

The conferences will focus on the dual target of addressing the migration challenge within the approach of intercultural dialogue, the presentation of the realities of migrants and refugees.

The conferences will bring European experts to discuss or debate key actions that are needed to frame an ethical and coherent European response and the need for understanding how we can use the European identity to in order to become European citizens based on the fundamental values of Human Rights. We aim to reach at least 300 people in all partner countries and to produce a contra-narrative report on this action.
